And if music was a way of listening to Life?

Water streams, wind blows, fire crackles, footsteps resounds on earth... The world surrounding us rustles, vibrates, sings, as well as the amazing musical fruit in the center of this show. Three musician singers are going to open it, feel it, taste it and play with it gradually, as a way of (re)experiencing together all first times. An awakening to life inspired by Mozart, Bach, Landi, Rossini... A moment of visual and musical poetry to share as a family.



The show

Tout Neuf ! is a dreamt immersion into awakening to life, by the time we weave our first links to the world. Each birth somehow replays the world's birth, from nothing to life. Tout Neuf ! proposes to write the poem of this journey, divided into nine steps.

The first astonishment of discovering oneself and the other ones gone through, the whole world appears to us as contained in a big mysterious egg... The interpreters are slowly going to unveil the nine pieces of this musical fruit. They will first discover all its richness and elements (air, water, fire, earth, metal) and then taste, touch, see, feel, listen to all sensations and emotions.

Each sound, object and material gradually turn into rhythms and melodies, instruments and music, and this conversion tells us about the story of awakening to the world.
